Code of Conduct

Students are expected to display appropriate behavior at all times. To assure the maximum enjoyment of the program by all participants, please review the following guidelines with your child. Your child is expected, at minimum, to:

- Show respect to all participants, staff and nature.
- Be pleasant to others and refrain from using foul language.
- Refrain from causing harm to self, other participants and staff.
- Use equipment, supplies and facilities properly.
- Stay with the group.

Discipline

If behavior problems arise, you will be contacted that day to discuss the nature of the problem. The following disciplinary techniques may be used for uncooperative children:

- Verbal warning Time out: the child is removed from the activity (but not from the vicinity) for a duration of up to one minute for each year of age.
- In extreme cases a child may be removed from the activity area if they have difficulty controlling themselves. In this case, you will be contacted to handle the situation.
- If problems persist or the behavior is severe such as causing intentional harm to others, we will request a conference with you.
- Children may be removed from the program for the day or rest of the week if problems cannot be resolved.
